The aim of this Journal is to promote an increased awareness of all aspects that ultimately lead to cancer prevention. The Journal publishes important original studies, reviews, editorials, short communications, and letters to the editor with multi-disciplinary perspectives in the areas of carcinogenesis, chemoprevention, molecular epidemiology, and cancer biology. The Journal publishes basic, clinical and translational research with special attention given to molecular and cellular discoveries of novel risk factors and chemopreventive agents.

JCP has been indexed in the PubMed Central archive, National Library of Medicine (NLM), and Google Scholar. Every manuscript appears in the PubMed. In addition, JCP has applied to SCOPUS in mid Dec.2014 and the acceptance will be decided soon. In addition, 2015 citation index was calculated as 1.525 by JCP's own analysis.
